**ANDAMAN & NICOBAR KHADI AND VILLAGE INDUSTRIES BOARD
(AMENDMENT) RULES, 2003**

No. 166/2003/F. No. 50-560/2000-Dev.I.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 38 of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Khadi & Village Industries Board Regulation, 1988 (No. 1 of 1988), the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman & Nicobar Islands, hereby makes the following amendments in the Andaman and Nicobar Khadi and Village Industries Board Rules, 2001 published vide Notification No. 219/2001/F.No. 50-469/2001-Dev. I, dated 05.12.2001, namely:—

1. SHORT TITLE, COMMENCEMENT AND EXTENT :—

- (i) These rules may be called the Andaman and Nicobar Khadi and Village Industries Board (Amendment) Rules, 2003.
- (ii) It extends to the whole of the Union Territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands.
- (iii) It shall come into force on such date as the Administrator may by Notification in the official Gazette notify.

2. AMENDMENT :—

After clause (XV) of rule 15B of the Andaman and Nicobar Khadi and Village Industries Board Rules, 2001 the following shall be added as under :

16. PURPOSE FOR WHICH GRANT-IN-AID MAY BE SANCTIONED TO THE ANDAMAN AND NICOBAR ISLANDS KHADI AND VILLAGE INDUSTRIES BOARD:

- (a) The Administrator may pay to the Board in each financial year, grant of such sum of money as he may consider necessary for its functioning as required under the Regulation.
- (b) The Grant-in-Aid paid to the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Khadi and Village Industries board shall be utilized for following purposes namely:—
 - (i) To meet expenses for salary and other remuneration of the Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary, Members, Financial Advisor and Chief Accounts Officer and other officers and employees of the Board including office expenses.
 - (ii) To meet expenses for payment of Provident Fund Scheme, Pension and Gratuity for the

17. GRANT -IN-AID :—

- (i) The Administrator will sanction Grants-in-Aid to Andaman and Nicobar Islands Khadi and Village Industries Board on quarterly basis on the basis of budget as approved by the Administrator as provided under Rule 20 of the Delegation of Financial Powers Rule on the basis of application received from the Board in respect of recurring/non-recurring expenditure. The details of recurring and non-recurring expenditure may be submitted to the A & N Administration alongwith application.
- (ii) The Board will maintain separate accounts in respect of Grants-in-Aid . the accounts will remain open for inspection by the officers representatives from the office of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India / Government of India/ Union Territory Administration. The board will have the accounts of the Grants-in-Aid audited and submit the complete set of copies of the following Audited Statement of accounts to the Administration:—
- (a) The Receipt and Payment Statement of accounts in respect of Grant-in-Aid sanctioned during previous year.
- (b) The Income and Expenditure Statement of accounts in respect of previous year.
- (c) The Balance Sheet.
- (d) The Utilization Certificate (GFR-19-A) alongwith the item-wise expenditure actually incurred may be submitted alongwith application for sanction of grants.
- (e) A statement in the prescribed form (GFR-19) in respect of Assets created from out of non-recurring grants in terms of the instructions contained in Rule 151 (4) of the General Financial Rules.
- (iii) The Board shall submit performance-cum-achievement report on the projects for which it received Grant-in-Aid.
- (iv) The Board will not divert Grant-in-Aid for the purposes other than for which sanctioned.
- (v) The Board will refund any unspent balance of Grant-in-Aid immediately after the close of relevant financial year unless adjusted by the Government from the subsequent Grant, which may fall due.
- (vi) No Assets acquired wholly or substantially from out of the Grant-in- Aid will be disposed off or encumbered and or otherwise utilized for the purpose other than for which sanctioned.
